Welcome to 1920s Chicago.

The Roaring Twenties is our favorite era—an intoxicating blend of Art Deco glamour, Prohibition, and open rebellion against Victorian morality. Fueled by the passage of the 19th Amendment and the newly won right to vote, women began carving out their own paths. 


Devin Baheshone






Rowan Cross





Emily Novicki Ensemble





Ashlynn Pettit Ensemble


