



Note From the Directors of Elf the Musical, Jr.

Our family cherishes our holiday traditions. One of our treasured traditions that evolved over the years has been our holiday family movie nights.

Before streaming or recording a show was possible, we gathered around the TV with our siblings to watch the Rankin and Bass classics *Rudolph The Red-Nosed Reindeer* and *Frosty the Snowman* plus *A Charlie Brown Christmas* on the only night the shows were aired.

Fast-forward to when Christina's oldest son was little, and she would purchase VHS tapes (and later DVDs), adding *A Christmas Story, The Grinch,* and *A Nightmare Before Christmas* to our list. We watched them on repeat during his holiday break.

Then, in 2003, a new Christmas movie *Elf* was released when our two youngest girls were babies. This was quickly added to our Christmas rotation and continues to be one of our favorites. There is such a wonderful innocence and simplicity that Buddy brings to a world of chaos and bitterness. He is such a great reminder for all of us to continue to see the world with child-like wonderment, joy and hope.

The musical version of *Elf* took the stage in 2010. This show is full of peppy earworms and conveys pure holiday joy! We are so excited to share this show with our theater families. With any musical based on a popular movie, delivering something fresh and new for our audience while staying true to the story is always challenging. But our cast and production team rose to the challenge and exceeded our expectations.

It certainly feels like the world could use a bit more of Buddy's perspective to spread kindness and good cheer all year round. It doesn't matter if you celebrate Christmas, Hanukkah, or Festivus (for the rest of us); holiday spirit and joy are universal. Our hope, as you watch the show, is that you can share some laughs with your loved ones, creating some holiday memories as this incredible cast "spreads some cheer by singing loud for all to hear."




Abby BaumbachDarlene / Featured Ensemble




Santa's Helper / Elf / Ensemble


Theodore McCombMatthews / Fake Santa / Featured Ensemble


Billie Murtagh Elf / Ensemble


Grace Nyen Elf / Ensemble


AJ Riddle Michael Hobbs





Sydney Underwood


