Note From the Directors of Les Misérables School Edition

"Whether true or false, what is said about men often has as much influence on their lives, and particularly on their destinies, as what they do." We and the cast discussed this Victor Hugo quote from *Les Misérables* at the beginning of our rehearsal process. We reviewed the history of France from the early- to mid-1800s; we explored how characters were translated from his novel into the musical; and we examined the themes that are made known throughout the narrative. An important theme that helped us craft this production is "Justice vs. Mercy."

Jean Valjean and Javert are opposing forces who grow and unravel on the very basis of this theme. They both pray to the same higher power for different purposes. When they each sing, "I am reaching, but I fall," it leads to drastically different outcomes for each character.

Javert sees everything in black and white, viewing Valjean only as a prisoner incapable of becoming anything more. Valjean, alternatively, makes consistent choices to right his wrongs on his path to redemption, but Javert is always at his heels with fire and brimstone at the ready. We must remember that they each represent two sides of the same holy coin: the God to which they are praying is described as both Just *and* Merciful.

The student protests that occur later in the show were events that Victor Hugo experienced himself. He saw barricades in the streets with his own eyes. While he could have written a novel about well-known French Revolutions occurring in the 19th century, he instead decided to tell what some might call an "unglamorous" story about everyday citizens struggling towards the light. Innumerable moments like these are usually lost to history, left undocumented from textbooks. Thanks to Victor, we are reminded that these were human beings with hopes and dreams, striving to live a meaningful life and survive until the next day.

We are very lucky to have worked with these 32 smart, talented, and dedicated actors. This is a crew who knows how to roll with the punches and they will absolutely knock your socks off! They took such ownership of the show and its meaning, and many of them already loved the musical a great deal before starting this process (as did we).

To the cast, their families, the entire creative team, and the Spotlight Youth Theatre community at large: THANK YOU! This show was made possible through your time, generosity, and support.

We hope you enjoy the show!
