Note From the Director

Before the first rehearsal for this production, I shared the notion with our cast and their family members that pretty much everybody knows the story of Rudolph. Diving deeper into the history, Rudolph has truly been a staple in every Christmas season for the past 84 years. Robert L. May wrote the book about Rudolph the Red-Nosed Reindeer in 1939, and it distributed 2.4 million copies in its first year of publication. May's brother-in-law, Johnny Marks, turned that story into a song, and it hit Number 1 on the Billboard charts in 1949. Arthur Rankin, Jr., and Jules Bass then adapted the song (without any other source material) into a stop-motion animated special in 1964, first airing on NBC. CBS has since aired that special on television every single year for the past five decades.

Today, in 2023, it can be very easy to fall into the mental trap of, "people would not want to see this show on stage when they have heard the story so many times." Or, even worse, "people do not care about this story anymore." If these assumptions were true, nobody would ever re-watch a Disney movie, dress like their favorite characters, or visit the parks. No one would get chills when they listen to their favorite song for the thousandth time. Theater artists would be bored with their craft when stepping onstage to perform the seventeenth run of a show. And yet, we still rewatch movies and cry. We still revisit theme parks and laugh. We still listen to our favorite music and smile. We still play dress up, we still tell stories, and we look forward to the chance to tell them again and again.


With Rudolph, he reminds us of a very important lesson at the end of every year: those who you think have the least to offer could be the ones with the most to give. This is a time of life when it is very easy to point out how we are different from our neighbor. "We look different...we have different ideals...we behave in a different manner...we could never get along..." the list goes on. Rudolph and his friends are a constant that we can depend upon, uniting us in spite of our differences whether we are 4 or 94 years old. Tradition and nostalgia are keys to our holiday spirit, and we hold them dear when we think the world might fall apart. We invite you to celebrate this story with us once again, lauding the misfit who saved Christmas.

I want to offer my sincerest thanks to Kenny for this opportunity and for his continual guidance and wisdom. To Josh and Katie, your support during and outside of rehearsals has been essential to this production's success, and I thank you deeply for all your dedication. To our designers: Brianna, Becky, Makayla, Addi, Nevaeh, Vicki Grossman, and Vicki Jensen, your artistry is simply top-notch, and I am the luckiest to have shared this experience with you. To the parents who assisted with lobby monitoring, set building, carpooling, and other volunteer positions, you keep the youth theatre world spinning and we could not have made it all work without your help.

And finally, to this incredible cast: Thank you for trusting me for these last several weeks, and thank you for bringing joy to this process each day. Never forget how much we adults need to see smiles like yours from time to time!

I hope everyone enjoys the show!
