


Note From the Director

Runaways was nominated for five Tony awards (1978) and paved the way for ground-breaking musicals such as *Rent*. Lin-Manuel Miranda credits Elizabeth Swados (the author) and *Runaways* for directly influencing him and his work on *In the Heights* and *Hamilton*.

Runaways is a unique piece of theater in that it's a collection of songs, dances, and spoken word pieces, performed with no plot or story line and no dialogue. The show was created from interviews with real runaway children and even featured runaways in the Broadway production.

This cast is proud to give a voice, energy, courage, and honesty to the invisible. Elizabeth Swados believed that the spoken word in music is gorgeous. We believe this show is gorgeous. This is not a show about blame; it's a show about listening and understanding. There's a poem at the end of the show where Olivia tells us, "Make laws against regret, otherwise you'd have to start with Adam and Eve." Let's hope one day we can stop creating a world of runaways.


